

HEATHCOTE PUBLIC SCHOOL AWARDS INFORMATION



Milo Award Tokens are our 'fast and frequent' awards. **Ten Milo tokens** are to be handed to the class teacher to be stamped and exchanged for a Merit Card. The tokens should then be taken to the office and placed in the red post box to go into a raffle to win a prize at the end of term.



Each Merit Card is worth **one point**. These can be awarded for ten blue tokens or for individual displays of commendable behaviour.



Assembly Awards are awarded to students for displaying outstanding behaviour and respect at assembly. Each Assembly Award is worth **one point**.



Sport Awards are awarded by PSSA coaches and class teachers to students who are trying hard at sport and displaying good sportsmanship. Each Sport Award is worth **one point**.



Principal's Awards for Home Reading are awarded to students who complete over 90% of their home reading each term. Each Principal's Award for Home Reading is worth **one point**.



Achievement Awards are awarded to students who display outstanding behaviour and effort. Each Achievement Award is worth **two points** and each recipient will have their name printed in the Magpie Messenger and their name read out at assembly.



This award is open to Year 6 students only and is worth **two points**. Recipients must display the following:

- Cooperation and consideration in all areas of school life
- Respect for themselves and others
- Responsibility for their actions
- Striving for their personal best
- Being an excellent role model to fellow students

AWARD CRITERIA



A student requires **ten points** to receive a Bronze Award. They will then present those awards to the office to have their Bronze Award printed ready to be presented at the next assembly. They will also have their name printed in the Magpie Messenger.



A student requires a Bronze Award plus **another ten points** to receive a Silver Award. They will then present those awards to the office to have their Silver Award printed ready to be presented at the next assembly. They will also have their name printed in the Magpie Messenger.



A student requires both a Bronze and Silver Award plus **another ten points** to receive a Gold Award. They will then present those awards to the office to have their Gold Award printed ready to be presented at the next assembly. They will also have their name printed in the Magpie Messenger and have a special morning tea with the principal.



Platinum Award

Once a student has received **four** Gold Awards they will then be presented with a framed Platinum Award.
